1) Licensure

109 new applications have been received and 66 licenses have been issued in 2013. There are currently 1683 total licensees, including 1313 active, 200 semi-active, 167 inactive, 3 on probation and 1 suspended.

2) Consumer Protection

37 complaints have been filed in 2013. There are currently 36 open cases under investigation (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration), with 5 in the contested case process. Of the open cases under investigation, 23 are regarding licensed practice, 4 are regarding applicants, and 9 are regarding unlicensed practice.

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
