1) Licensure

20 new applications have been received and 12 licenses have been issued in 2014. There are currently 1727 total licensees, including 1343 active, 201 semi-active, 175 inactive, 1 on probation and 3 suspended.

2) Consumer Protection

11 complaints have been filed in 2014. There are currently 32 open cases under investigation (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration), with 2 in the contested case process. Of the open cases under investigation, 22 are regarding licensed practice, 1 is an applicant, and 9 are unlicensed practice.
