XVIII. **STATISTICS** (Information Only)

1) Licensure

47 new applications have been received and 38 licenses have been issued in 2014. There are currently 1730 total licensees, including 1354 active, 195 semi-active, 178 inactive, and 3 suspended.

2) Consumer Protection

25 complaints have been filed in 2014. There are currently 36 open cases under investigation (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration), with 2 in the contested case process. Of the open cases

under investigation, 25 are regarding licensees, 2 regarding applicants, and 9 are regarding unlicensed practice.
