RULE SUMMARY

Senate Bill 230 (SB 230) passed during the 2015 Regular Session and amended ORS 676.410. This added a requirement that certain healthcare workforce regulatory boards, including the Board of Psychologist Examiners, collaborate with the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) and adopt rules that will require renewing licensees to provide specified information and pay a fee established by OHA. This proposed rule amendment implements SB 230 by requiring that licensed psychologists and psychologist associates, in order to complete their biennial license renewal, must pay the fee established by OHA and complete the healthcare workforce data survey. This requirement will begin with renewals due in July of 2016.

The Agency requests public comment on whether other options should be considered for achieving the rule's substantive goals while reducing negative economic impact of the rule on business.

This proposed rule amendment implements the requirements SB 230.

Licensed psychologists and psychologist associates will be required to pay a fee established by the Oregon Health Authority; this is currently \$4 for each two-year license renewal.
