1) Licensure

69 new applications have been received and 39 licenses have been issued in 2016. There are currently 185 active applications- including 68 practicing residents. There are 1,881 licensees: 1,509 active, 192 semi-active, 178 inactive, and 2 suspended.

2) Consumer Protection

40 complaints have been filed in 2016. There are currently 30 open cases (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration): 21 licensees, 2 applicants, and 7 unlicensed practice cases. There are 3 contested cases, and 3 cases on appeal.
