20 new applications have been received and 10 licenses have been issued in 2017. There are currently 178 active applications- including 73 practicing residents. There are 1,937 licensees: 1,571 active, 199 semi-active, 180 inactive, 1 suspended, and 1 on probation.

b) Consumer Protection

16 complaints have been filed in 2017. There are currently 50 open cases (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration): 32 licensees, 7 applicants, and 11 unlicensed practice cases. There are 4 contested cases and 3 cases on appeal.
