34 new applications have been received and 32 licenses have been issued in 2017. There are currently 165 active applications- including 67 practicing residents. There are 1,962 licensees: 1,574 active, 201 semi-active, 185 inactive, 1 suspended, and 1 on probation.

b) Consumer Protection

25 complaints have been filed in 2017. There are currently 56 open cases (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration): 39 licensees, 5 applicants, and 12 unlicensed practice cases. There are 3 contested cases and 2 cases on appeal.
