67 new applications have been received and 45 licenses have been issued in 2017. There are currently 178 active applications- including 67 practicing

residents. There are 1,970 licensees: 1,579 active, 201 semi-active, 187 inactive, 2 suspended, and 1 on probation.

b) Consumer Protection

35 complaints have been filed in 2017. There are currently 60 open cases (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration): 43 licensees, 5 applicants, and 12 unlicensed practice cases. There is 1 contested case and 2 cases on appeal.
