112 new applications have been received and 64 licenses have been issued in 2017. There are currently 195 active applications- including 75 practicing residents. There are 1,977 licensees: 1,588 active, 201 semi-active, 185 inactive, 2 suspended, and 1 on probation.

b) Consumer Protection

46 complaints have been filed in 2017. There are currently 65 open cases (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration): 46 licensees, 8 applicants, and 11 unlicensed practice cases. There is 1 contested case and 3 cases on appeal.
