## 8) **STATISTICS**

### a) Licensure

159 new applications have been received and 124 licenses have been issued in 2017. There are currently 173 active applications- including 93 practicing residents. There are 2,014 licensees: 1,601 active, 212 semi-active, 198 inactive, 2 suspended, and 1 on probation.

### b) Consumer Protection

68 complaints have been filed in 2017. There are currently 68 open cases (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration): 47 licensees, 7 applicants, and 14 unlicensed practice cases. There are 6 contested cases and 2 cases on appeal.
