a) Licensure

15 new applications have been received and 13 licenses have been issued in 2018. There are currently 172 active applications- including 95 practicing residents. There are 2,014 licensees: 1,601 active, 212 semi-active, 199 inactive, 2 suspended, and 1 on probation.

b) Consumer Protection

6 complaints have been filed in 2018. There are currently 65 open cases (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration): 44 licensees, 5 applicants, and 16 unlicensed practice cases. There are 10 contested cases and 2 cases on appeal.
