35 new applications have been received and 29 licenses have been issued in 2018. There are currently 173 active applications- including 99 practicing residents. There are 2,012 licensees: 1,593 active, 215 semi-active, 201 inactive, 2 suspended, and 1 on probation.

**b) Consumer Protection**

20 complaints have been filed in 2018. There are currently 74 open cases (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration): 52 licensees, 6 applicants, and 16 unlicensed practice cases. There are 8 contested cases and 2 cases on appeal.
