67 new applications have been received and 43 licenses have been issued in 2018. There are currently 189 active applications- including 94 practicing residents. There are 2,016 licensees: 1,594 active, 213 semi-active, 205 inactive, 3 suspended, and 1 on probation.
- b) Consumer Protection

31 complaints have been filed in 2018. There are currently 68 open cases (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration): 46

licensees, 5 applicants, and 17 unlicensed practice cases. There are 6 contested cases and 2 cases on appeal.
