152 new applications have been received and 102 licenses have been issued in 2018. There are currently 209 active applications- including 121 practicing residents. There are 2,048 licensees: 1,607 active, 221 semi-active, 216 inactive, 1 suspended, and 3 on probation.

b) Consumer Protection

45 complaints have been filed in 2018. There are currently 66 open cases (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration): 46 licensees, 5 applicants, and 15 unlicensed practice cases. There are 4 contested cases and 2 cases on appeal.
