##### **a) Licensure**

15 new applications have been received and 12 licenses have been issued in 2019. There are currently 199 active applications- including 111 practicing residents. There are 2,062 licensees: 1,613 active, 227 semi-active, 218 inactive, 1 suspended, and 3 on probation.

##### **b) Consumer Protection**

10 complaints have been filed in 2019. There are currently 71 open cases (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration): 51 licensees, 6 applicants, and 14 unlicensed practice cases. There are 4 contested cases and 2 cases on appeal.
