a) Licensure

145 new applications have been received and 130 licenses have been issued in 2019. There are currently 187 active applications- including 92 practicing residents. There are 2,125 licensees: 1,676 active, 217 semi-active, 228 inactive, 1 suspended, and 3 on probation.

b) Consumer Protection

51 complaints have been filed in 2019. There are currently 55 open cases (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration): 43 licensees, 1 applicant, and 11 unlicensed practice cases. There are 7 contested cases and 2 cases on appeal.
