Current as of 12/27/19

a) Licensure

160 new applications have been received and 145 licenses have been issued in 2019. There are currently 177 active applications- including 87 practicing residents. There are 2,114 licensees: 1,675 active, 215 semi-active, 218 inactive, 1 suspended, and 5 on probation.

b) Consumer Protection

61 complaints have been filed in 2019. There are currently 57 open cases (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration): 47 licensees, 1 applicant, and 9 unlicensed practice cases. There are 5 contested cases and 2 cases on appeal.
