ALTERNATE PROJECT DELIVERY AND ACCELERATED BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION



Highways for LIFE is sponsoring a project showcase: the replacement of five substandard major structures on Oregon's Umpqua River Highway, a major corridor between Interstate 5 and U.S. 101 near Elkton, Ore. The Oregon Department of Transportation is replacing the bridges for a variety of reasons:

- Load ratings indicate a lack of sufficient capacity to carry permit vehicles
- Substandard bridge widths
- Repair costs for structural and functional deficiencies exceed one-half of the replacement costs
- To avoid a 50-mile detour for commercial vehicles

Attendees will also participate in a site visit to witness a rapid replacement bridge slide.
