**RULE SUMMARY**

**RULE SUMMARY**

The amendments to 111-002-0005 include early retirees and dependents as well as the educational entities that we provide services to and ultimately impact. Other amendments to this rule also include statements about what authority may be delegated to staff. Previously, this was in the OEBB By-laws but did not exist in rule. These amendments incorporate into rule several statements that are written in policy or the Board By-laws. Based upon this new knowledge and review of our rules, it was determined that it is very important to include several statements that guide our administrative processes into rule. All amendments have been reviewed by DOJ.
