RULE SUMMARY

Amendments to 111-030-0050 reflect the Oregon Educators Benefit Board's decision to continue to allow Employee Groups who are currently using a composite rate structure for Long Term Disability for both employer-paid and employee-paid plans. In addition, the amendments to this rule also reflect the OEBB Board's decision to expand the availability of the composite rate structure to those Employee Groups who choose to elect an employer-paid plan option on Long Term Disability.

The Agency requests public comment on whether other options should be considered for achieving the rule's substantive goals while reducing negative economic impact of the rule on business.
