"NG911" services mean a secure, Internet Protocol (IP)-based, open standards system comprised of hardware, software, data, and operational policies and procedures that:  • Provides standardized interfaces from emergency call and message services to support emergency communications.  • Processes all types of emergency calls, including voice, text, data, and multimedia information.  • Acquires and integrates additional emergency call data useful to call routing and handling.  • Delivers the emergency calls, messages, and data to the appropriate, public safety answering point [PSAP] and other appropriate emergency entities based on the location of the caller.  • Supports data, video, and other communications needs for coordinated incident response and management.  • Interoperates with services and networks used by first responders [and other 911 systems] to facilitate emergency response.
