## Call for Artists

Main Street Oregon City Inc. is excited to be hosting the Fourth Annual First City Celebration on Main Street in Downtown Oregon City this July 27<sup>th</sup> 2013. The First City Celebration proudly features regional artists showcasing their work in open air street festival vending booth settings.

While the Artist Registration Form attached is less of an application than a registration form, the event coordinator reserves the right to inquire further into the nature of each artist and their work to ensure it is compatible and acceptable for the First City Celebration Street Festival.

Artist applications for the First City Celebration are **due no later June 21<sup>st</sup> 2013**.

### Event details are as follows:

- The event runs from Noon to 9:00 PM.
  - Set up times are 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM.
  - Take down times are 9:00 PM to 11:00 PM.
    - The public expects Artists to stay up and open through 9:00 PM.
- All displayed art must be made by participating artists.
  - Individual partitions will be 10' x 10' grouped into four-section quads giving each Artist two open sides.
  - Artists will provide their own tent, display equipment, and do their own set up and take down. Artists will be responsible for their own sales transactions and staff.
- Each 10' x 10' partition is \$75 (one Artist per partition strictly enforced).
  - Preferential placement of Artists given to applications received before March 31<sup>st</sup>.
    - All Artist placements are at the discretion of the event coordinator.
- Interactive demonstrations or hands on activities are encouraged.
- Off street parking is provided for artists.
- No electricity is provided at this event.

\* Artists are encouraged to submit one to three photographs of their work with their application to be used for outreach and promotion prior to the event.
