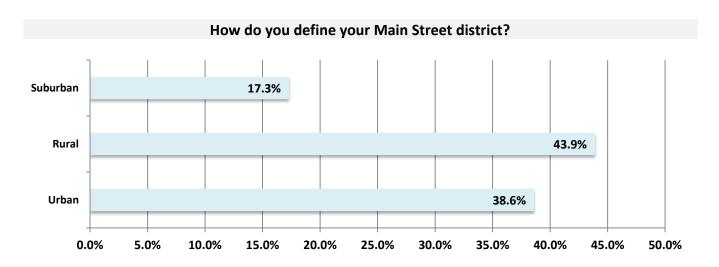
2015 National Main Street Network Trends Survey Results

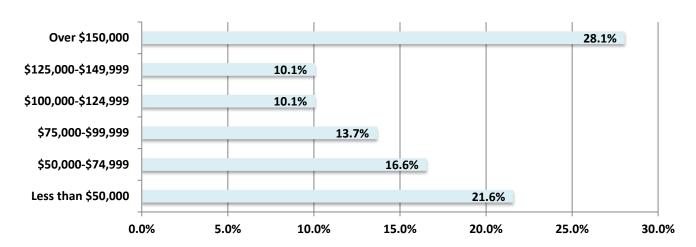
