from 2020-2025 Strategic Plan

- 1. Develop a business incubator facility
- 2. Continue work with the City and Travel Oregon as to establish a Destination Management Organization on behalf of the City.
- 3. Develop public art throughout the business district
- 4. Improve 5 properties in the business corridor
- 5. Draft language for discussion purposes with the City to potentially adopt regulations limiting storage and "for sale" advertisement of vehicles and boats on Hwy 101.
- 6. Dialogue with Pacific High school for potential student community service for beautification of the business corridor.
