The definition has a specific nationwide program listed. By changing the rule to more generic language, the State Library will be able to compare different programs to determine which is the best fit for Oregon libraries.

Oregon Revised Statute 357.750 (available from the Oregon State Legislature) and Oregon Administrative Rules 543-040-0010 (available from Secretary of State, Archives Division)

There will be no fiscal impact on Oregon libraries. The fiscal impact on the State Library will remain the same.

## 543-040-0010

Definitions-of Statewide Summer Reading Program ¶

The following definitions apply to the terms used in this division:

- (1) "Board": Has the meaning given to "Board" in OAR 543-010-0003(1).¶
- (2) "Fiscal Year": Means the period of one year commencing on July 1 and closing on June 30.¶
- (3) "Per Child": Means for each child from birth to 14 years of age, residing in a geographic area.¶
- (4) "Public Library": Has the meaning given to "public library" in ORS 357.400(3).  $\P$
- (5) "Statewide summer reading program": Means the Collaborative Summer Library Program Aany national or statewide annual  $S_{\underline{s}}$  ummer  $R_{\underline{r}}$  eading  $P_{\underline{p}}$  rogram funprovided by the State Library for Oregon public libraries.
