Not only will you receive important updates, you'll also be following the rules! State rules require that you **notify us of any changes within 60 days**, so keep that information current!

CONTINUING EDUCATION AUDIT

The annual Continuing Education (CE) audit is underway. CE is a critical component of the Board's mission to protect the public health, safety, and welfare. The CE audit is conducted to determine if registrants are meeting the CE requirements listed in Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 806-010-0145. Each renewal cycle, eight percent of registered architects who submitted renewal applications are randomly selected for the CE audit.

OSBAE would like to remind registrants that we require 24 hours of CE in architectural health, safety, and welfare (HSW) subjects to renew or reinstate an architect certificate of registration. Evidence of compliance must be maintained by the architect for a minimum of two years. Acceptable evidence of completion is a certificate or transcript that includes the name of the course provider, registrant's name, course title, completion date, and HSW hours received.

Please see OAR 806-010-0145 for the details regarding CE, as well as the flowchart that is available on our website. It's important to note that failing to comply with CE requirements, or making false statements or misrepresentations related to CE activities, may result in disciplinary action by the Board.


