#### **INDIVIDUAL RENEWAL INFORMATION (ARI)**

The renewal deadline for an architect's certificate of registration depends on your ARI number:

- Even-numbered ARIs: Renew by December 31 of even-numbered years.
- Odd-numbered ARIs: Renew by December 31 of odd-numbered years.

If your ARI ends in an odd number, your registration expires December 31, 2025.

#### **Renewal Notices**

Renewal notices will be emailed on **November 4, 2025** to the address we have on file. This email will include your unique PIN and instructions for accessing the online renewal system.

You may also visit our website (see Registrants  $\rightarrow$  Renewal) after November 4 to request your renewal PIN.

**Important:** A new PIN is issued for each renewal. Previous PINs cannot be reused.

#### **Renewal Requirements**

To renew your architect certificate of registration, you must:

- Complete the online renewal process and certify that you have met the continuing education (CE) requirements under OAR 806-010-0145.
- Pay all applicable fees:
  - o Two-year renewal fee: \$240
  - Late renewal fee: \$150 (if renewed after December 31)
  - Late CE fee: \$240 (if CE is completed after December 31)

#### **Late Renewal & CE Deadlines**

Your renewal is considered late if you have not completed the renewal requirements by **December 31**, **2025**. If you fail to renew, your certificate of registration will become **inactive on March 2**, **2026**, and you may not practice architecture in Oregon.

Continuing education is considered late if not completed by **December 31, 2025**.

#### **Prepare Now!**

- Keep your contact information current: Make updates via the <u>ONLINE option</u> or go to <u>https://www.oregon.gov/osbae/Pages/Update-Contact-Information.aspx</u> and submit the form.
- Mark your calendar: Check for your renewal notice on or after **November 4, 2025**. If you do not receive an email from <a href="mailto:architectboard@osbae.oregon.gov">architectboard@osbae.oregon.gov</a>, check your junk or spam folder.

#### FIRM RENEWAL INFORMATION (ARF)

The renewal deadline for an architectural firm's certificate of registration is January 31 of each year.

#### **Renewal Notices**

Renewal notices will be emailed to firms on **December 9, 2025** to the address we have on file. This email will include your unique PIN and instructions for accessing the online renewal system.

You may also visit our website (see Registrants → Renewal) after December 9 to request your renewal PIN.

Important: A new PIN is issued for each renewal. Previous PINs cannot be reused.

#### **Renewal Requirements**

To renew your firm's certificate of registration, the designated firm representative must:

- Complete the renewal information online; and
- Pay all required fees:
  - o One-year renewal fee: \$200
  - Late renewal fee: \$150 (if renewed after January 31)

#### **Late Renewal & Inactive Status**

Your renewal is considered late if you have not completed the renewal requirements by **January 31, 2026**. If you fail to renew, your certificate of registration will become **inactive on April 2, 2026**, and your firm may not provide architectural services in Oregon.

#### **Prepare Now!**

# HOW TO PREPARE FOR A CONTINUING EDUCATION (CE) AUDIT

## Review the Rules

Before renewing, familiarize yourself with <u>OAR 806-010-0145</u> (Continuing Education) and <u>OAR 806-010-0090</u> (Renewal of Registration).

## **©** Complete 24 HSW Hours

- **24 HSW Hours:** Complete 24 hours of health, safety, and welfare (HSW) CE before your registration expires
- No Carryover: CE cannot roll over to the next 2-year period
- Expiration Dates:
  - o ARI ending in an **even number:** Dec. 31, even years
  - o ARI ending in an **odd number:** Dec. 31, odd years

#### **★** Keep Your CE Records in Order

Gather and organize documentation **before renewing**. Acceptable records include:

- Certificates of completion that meet the requirements in OAR 806-010-0145(6)
  - Certificates or transcripts showing course provider name, registrant name, course title, completion date, and HSW hours awarded
- NOT accepted as proof of CE include personal logs or spreadsheets, proof of course registration, course descriptions

Keep CE records for at least two years from your most recent date of registration or renewal in Oregon.

# Renew Online & Attest to CE Completion

When renewing online, you will be asked to attest to CE completion. Be truthful — **false attestation may result in disciplinary action, including civil penalties**. You will select one of the following statements:

#### On-time completion:

As outlined in OAR 806-010-0145, I confirm I will complete a minimum of 24 hours of continuing education in health, safety, and welfare between January 1, 2024 and December 31, 2025, OR I confirm this is my first renewal with OSBAE.

#### Late completion:

As outlined in OAR 806-010-0145, I confirm I will complete a minimum of 24 hours of continuing education in health, safety, and welfare between January 1, 2024 and March 1, 2026, and will pay the late continuing education fee with this renewal.

# OREGON BUILDING CODES DIVISION (BCD) PLAN REVIEW EXCEPTION FOR ONE- AND TWO-FAMILY DWELLINGS

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 455.628 provides an exception to the required plan review for one- and two-family dwellings of conventional light-frame construction where certain conditions are met.

#### Plan review exception – ORS 455.628

ORS 455.628 specifies that a local building department may not require a plan review for one- and two-family dwellings that are of conventional light frame construction if:

- The plans for the dwelling are designed and stamped by a registered professional engineer or a registered architect; **and**
- The engineer or architect is certified by the Building Codes Division as being qualified to examine one- and two-family dwelling plans.

Conventional light-frame construction is defined as construction whose primary structural elements are formed by a system of repetitive wood-framing members.

#### **Required certifications**

According to Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 918-098-1015, persons who possess the following certifications may review construction plans for compliance with the provisions of the Oregon Residential Specialty Code (ORSC):

- 1. Oregon Inspector Certification (OIC)
- 2. Residential Plans Examiner (CAX)

Both certifications are issued by the division through the Inspector Training Program.

#### Obtaining the required certifications

1. To obtain the OIC, complete the OIC class provided by the Inspector Training Program. The class explains the roles and responsibilities of plans examiners.

- 2. To obtain the CAX certification, complete the following:
  - a. Take and pass the International Code Council (ICC) exam for the Residential Plans Examiner (ICC R3) certification.

  - b. Convert the ICC R3 certification to the CAX certification.
