1. Dial the audio conference dial-in number noted above and enter the passcode as prompted.
2. Type in this meeting URL:

3. On the Meeting Center page, enter:
 - Your name
 - E-mail address
 - Company (or Institution)
4. Click on the "**Sign-in**" button.
5. Accept the Terms and Conditions and click "**Join**" to enter your conference.

Should your computer require any updates to accommodate web conferencing, an additional message will be displayed. Follow the instructions to prepare your computer for the meeting. These updates should take 5 to 10 minutes to complete.

What is a Webinar?

Webinar is short for Web-based seminar. Webinar's are just like a conference room based seminar, however, participants view the presentation through their Web-browser and listen to the audio through their telephone. A key feature of a Webinar is its interactive elements -- the ability to give, receive and discuss information. Contrast with "Webcast", in which the data transmission is one way and does not allow interaction between the presenter and the audience.

IMPORTANT

To participate in this Web Conference you will need a telephone to listen to the audio conference **AND** a computer with internet connectivity to view the web conference.
