

SPR&I Annual Sub-Grant & Suggested Activities

Districts/programs in Oregon receiving funds under IDEA are required to participate in the Oregon Department of Education's (ODE's) Systems Performance Review & Improvement (SPR&I) system of accountability and annual performance reporting.

SPR&I is a district/program driven system founded on evidence based decision-making. It supports improvement planning through the (1) collection and interpretation of data, (2) development and implementation of an improvement plan, and (3) evaluation of impact and effectiveness of improvement strategies. SPR&I aligns with IDEA required General Supervision requirements and improvement planning.

Sub-Grant Awards: Small formula grants are awarded to districts/programs annually to assist in completing required activities of the SPR&I system. These sub-grant awards are disseminated by ODE prior to the beginning of the school year.

Use of Sub-Grant Funds: These funds may be used to support SPR&I monitoring and compliance activities, such as:

- Attending the 2018-19 Spotlight on Successful Practices Fall trainings
- Completing the Procedural Compliance Review (PCR) files
- Analyzing indicator data and completing indicator tasks (consolidated plans for School Age and worksheets, policy-to-practice, improvement plans, and corrective action plans for EI/ECSE)
- Training staff in the areas of identified need based on the SPR&I data, reports and plans

Funds also may be used to support:

- Teacher salaries when duties are linked to special education, such as attending special education inservice training and participating in special education meetings
- Substitute teacher costs for special education or general education teachers when performing duties involving special education
- Clerical support when the duties are linked to special education
- Registration fees, travel and conference expenses associated with special education inservice training
- Duplication and dissemination of materials provided at the special education trainings
- Printing costs related to the Procedural Safeguards Booklet
- Post-Secondary Outcomes (PSO) Collection – required one year follow-up calls

**Please note that all costs must follow [IDEA Part B Regulations](#) and any unused funds are liquidated.*
