

SNAP Replacements due to Electronic Thefts

Approved State plan effective May 23:

- Requires reporting theft within 30 days of discovery
- Limited to replacement of LESSER of either:
 - Past 2 months of SNAP issuances or
 - Actual amount stolen
 - Limited to 2 replacements per Federal Fiscal Year (Oct 1 - Sep 30)

***Thefts that occurred on or after Oct 1, 2022, need to be reported by June 21, 2023**

****No change to SNAP replacement of food damaged by misfortunes.**

Temporary Student Exemptions: EFC & Work Study Phase Out

New SNAP applicants:

- Applications filed on or before June 10 may still use them

Renewal Applications

- Applications renewed on or before June 30 may still use them
- Not allowed to renew a case before its 12th month

***If SNAP approved based on temporary student exemptions, the exemption will be used for the duration of the certification period.**

****This phase out is not impacting regular student exemptions.**

Work Requirements start July 1, 2023: For individuals with an ABAWD status

- **DO NOT APPLY IF INDIVIDUAL:**

- Meets one of the allowable exemptions (including 3 NEW exemptions)
 - Lives in a waived area (22 counties & 10 Tribal Lands)
 - No longer meets definition of ABAWD status (aged out or child in home)
- Those who live in **Clackamas, Deschutes, Jackson, Lane, Linn, Marion, Multnomah and Washington** will be referred by ABAWD Team to OED for Case Management services.
- Those who live in **Benton, Columbia, Hood River, Malheur, Polk and Yamhill** will be screened for exemptions or Discretionary Exemptions.
