

Helping people claim their cash from tax credits

Cash is still available through state and federal tax credits, even for people who are not required to file a return or who do not have a Social Security number.

- As many as 50,000 families with incomes between \$0 and \$30,000 may still be eligible for the new Oregon Kids Credit of up to \$1000 per dependent under age six.
- Cash rebates are still available for those that didn't file during the pandemic. By filing tax returns going back as far as 2020, people may be eligible for the economic impact payments and other refundable credits.
- People can file after April 15 without penalty, if they don't owe any tax.
- Free help is available beginning in May through October 15. Call 2-1-1 or visit [211Info.org](https://211info.org) to find a local VITA site.
