PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1560

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, delete "creating new provisions; 2 amending ORS 743A.058;".

3 Delete lines 5 through 30.

4 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 24 and insert:

5 "SECTION 1. (1) A work group on telemedicine is established.

6 "(2) The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business 7 Services shall appoint the members of the work group. The work group 8 must include, at a minimum:

9 "(a) Two physicians licensed to practice medicine or osteopathy in 10 this state.

11 "(b) Two medical directors of health plans.

"(c) A medical doctor or nurse practitioner employed by an urgent
 care facility.

14 "(d) Two representatives of hospitals.

15 "(e) A representative of the Telehealth Alliance of Oregon.

16 "(f) A representative who is employed in the Insurance Division of

17 the Department of Consumer and Business Services.

18 "(g) A representative of a self-insured health plan.

¹⁹ "(h) A representative of the Oregon Health Authority.

"(3) The work group shall evaluate next steps in the development
of telemedicine in this state, including, but not limited to, a consideration of all of the following:

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1 "(a) Existing statutes related to telemedicine.

"(b) Legislative proposals related to telemedicine from prior legislative sessions.

4 "(c) The possibility of expanding the use of telemedicine, and 5 methods of holding down the costs of expansion.

6 "(d) Potential legislative concepts.

7 "(4) A majority of the members of the work group constitutes a
8 quorum for the transaction of business.

9 "(5) Official action by the work group requires the approval of a 10 majority of the members of the work group.

11 "(6) The work group shall elect one of its members to serve as 12 chairperson.

13 "(7) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the Director of the De-14 partment of Consumer and Business Services shall make an appoint-15 ment to become immediately effective.

"(8) The work group shall meet at times and places specified by the
 call of the chairperson or of a majority of the members of the work
 group.

19 "(9) The work group may adopt rules necessary for the operation
20 of the work group.

"(10) The work group shall submit a report in the manner provided
in ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to
the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health
care no later than October 31, 2014.

²⁵ "(11) The Department of Consumer and Business Services shall U_{γ}^{γ} ²⁶ provide staff support to the work group.

"(12) Members of the work group are not entitled to compensation
or reimbursement for expenses and serve as volunteers on the work
group.
